2005 trophy-hunting-season

The trophy hunting season is coming to an end; on the 30th of November we will clean our barrels from the seasons foulings. In mid November, we will guide our last group of hunters; in the meantime, we can already draw up the past season's statistics:

We hosted 36 guests, 24 of them were hunters, who hunted a total of 154 days with us.

Among those hunters, 13 were new guests, 11 the second time (or even more) our valued guests and one hunter even returned for a second time for this year to hunt with us. The hunters were from Germany, Finland, France and Italy. Ten of them hunted in the ranch area only, two opted for Doro !Nawas only and all others favoured a combination between hunting in Doro !Nawas and the ranching area.

All in all, a very successful season with fascinating hunting adventures and prime trophies is lying behind us.

2006 hunting season

Next years hunting season is already in the planning stage. Our mobility is greatly extended by a second new LandCruiser pick-up.

In November next year (2006), our hunting contract with the Doro !Nawas Conservancy will expire. Next year will thus be our last year to hunt this magnificent area!

We were, however, offered hunting rights in the Kaokoveld, but this popped out to be a fenced-off area, wrapped into an electric fence.
